**I. A Plurality of Churches Take an Offering**

Romans 15:26

**Application:** In the case of missions giving, we should join with other churches of like doctrine in supporting missions.

**II. The Particulars of the Offering**

**A. It Should Be Planned**

**Application:** If I don't plan to give, then I will not give.

**B. It Should Be Proportional**

**Application:** is to give in proportion to how much God has blessed them. (Mark 12:41-44)

**C. It Should Be Pledged (II Cor. 9:7)**

**Application:** I determine how much I can give and still be cheerful

**D. It Should Be Protected (I Cor 16:3)**

**Application:** The church must show integrity with the money offered to missions.

**III. The Product of the Offering (II Cor. 9:7-11)**

- Give bountifully
- Give cheerfully

Phil 4:15

**Application:** When I give bountifully & cheerfully God will provide for my needs and produce more righteous fruit.

**What is Faith Promise giving?**

Faith promise giving is a program based upon Biblical principles where a plurality of churches regularly collect money pledged by their individual members in order to support missionaries. This money is then entrusted to a trusted missions agency or church that delivers it to the missionary.
