Tuition

Tuition rates are established with the primary goal of keeping Christian education as affordable as possible. Tuition can be paid in three ways:

- 1) Full annual payment
- 2) ½ year each semester
- 3) 10 month payment plan

There is a 10% discount available if tuition is paid in full by Sept. 1.

Enrollment Fees

- 1) * **The early registration fee is \$125 prior to July 15; thereafter, it is \$150 per student.**
- 2) New student Admissions Testing fee is \$15, payable at the time of testing.
- 3) Book fees vary by grade level. Fees must be paid by the first day of school.
- 4) * Financial aid applications must be received no later than July 1.

Financial Aid

Tuition assistance information is available upon request. Assistance is limited. Applications are available from the school office and must be turned in by July 1 for consideration.
